Build your DAX expression on the PowerPivot Formula bar more or less as you build an Excel formula in a cell of one of its worksheets. To use a DAX function in the expression, click the Insert Function button on the PowerPivot Formula bar and select the function to use in the Insert Function dialog box (which is very similar to the standard Excel Insert Function dialog box except that it contains only DAX functions).

The Data Analysis Expressions (DAX) language is a formula language for Power Pivot, Power BI Desktop, and Tabular modeling in SQL Server Analysis Services (SSAS), which allows users to define custom calculations in PowerPivot tables (calculated columns) and in Excel PivotTables (measures).

DAX stands for Data Analysis Expression. It is a special language we use to create measures in Power Pivot. Although it is a special language, it looks exactly like our regular Excel formulas. That means you can easily learn the DAX basics and create measures in no time.

To create a DAX formula for a calculated field in the Excel window, use the Calculated Field dialog box. To create a DAX formula for a calculated field in the Power Pivot window, click a cell in the calculation area in the relevant table. Start the DAX formula with CalculatedFieldName:=. For example, Total East Sales Amount:=SUM ((East_Sales[Amount])

Unlike traditional Excel Pivot Tables, Power Pivot allows you to analyze hundreds of millions of rows across multiple data tables (inside of Excel!), and create supercharged calculated fields using a formula language called Data Analysis Expressions (or "DAX" for short).

You cannot use a DAX formula in an Excel workbook, and vice versa. They can only be used in the Power Pivot window and in PivotTables that are based on Power Pivot data. Also, although the functions have identical names, the behavior may be slightly different. For more information, see the individual function reference topics.

Aggregations in Power Pivot - Excel

A calculated field in a table in a Data Model is the field obtained by a DAX formula. In earlier versions of Power Pivot, the calculated field was termed as a measure. In Excel 2013, it was renamed as a calculated field. However, it is renamed back to measure in Excel 2016.
